Powered by the MediaTek Genio 700/500 (MT8390/MT8370), featuring high-performance Cortex-A78 and high-efficiency Cortex-A55 cores, the MXA-312M provides a versatile open-platform design for next-generation IoT applications.

1.4 Connecting DC Power

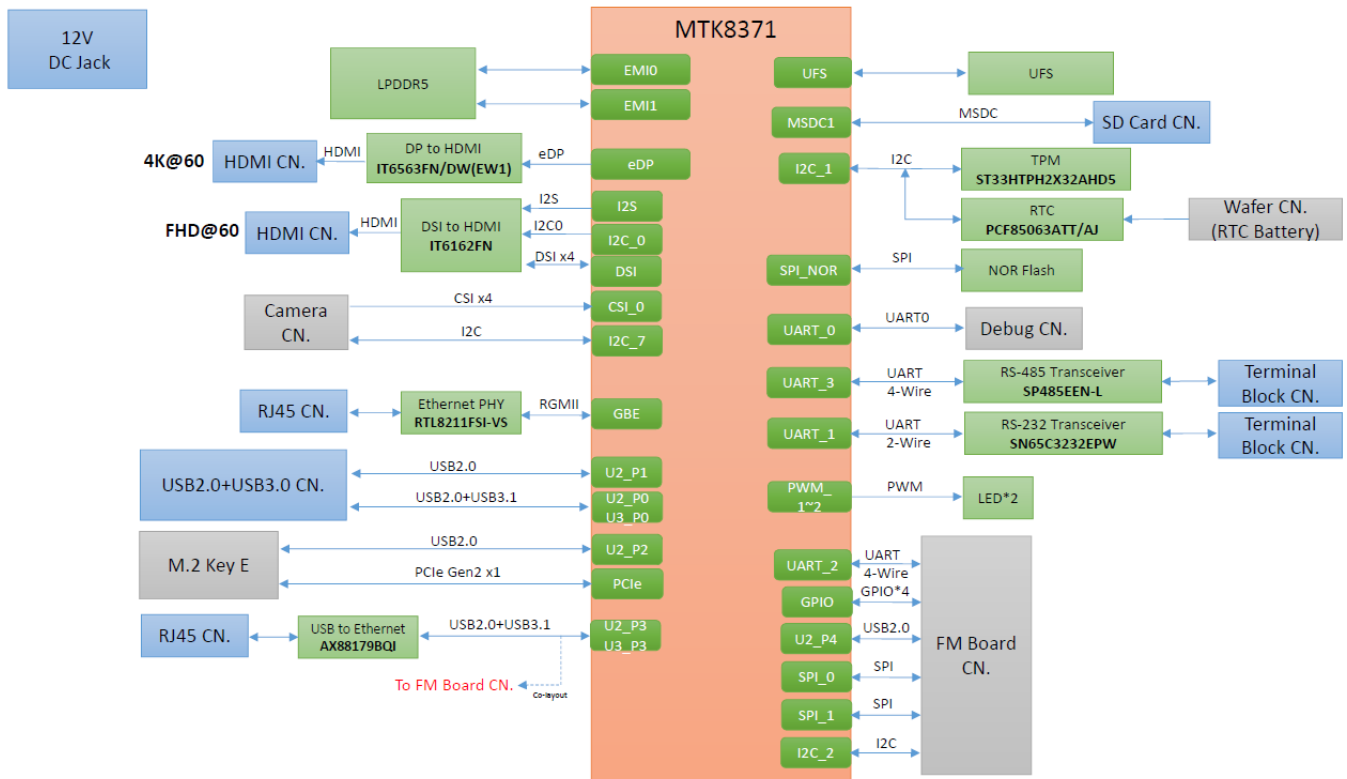


Figure 1: Functional block diagram

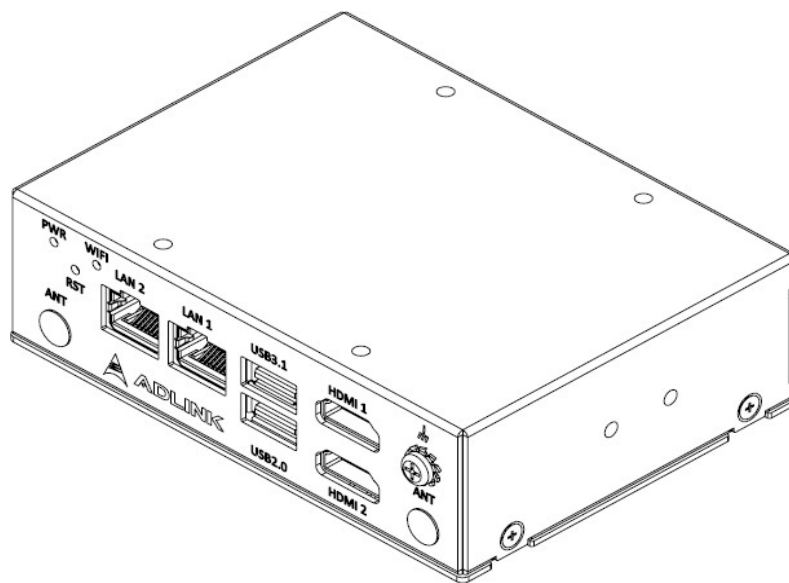


Figure 2: Top view

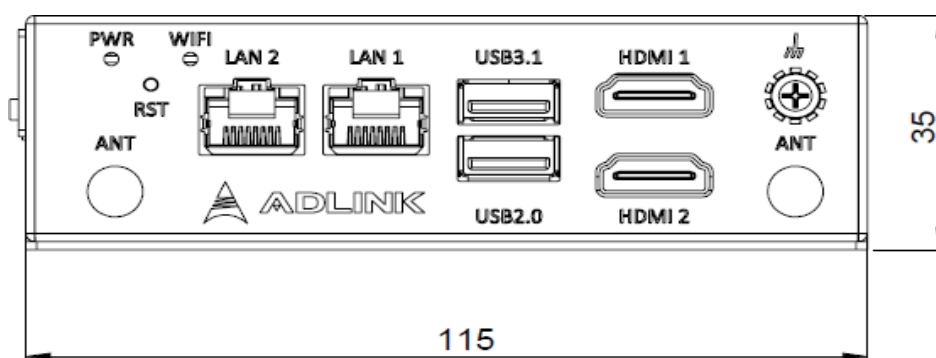


Figure 3: Front view

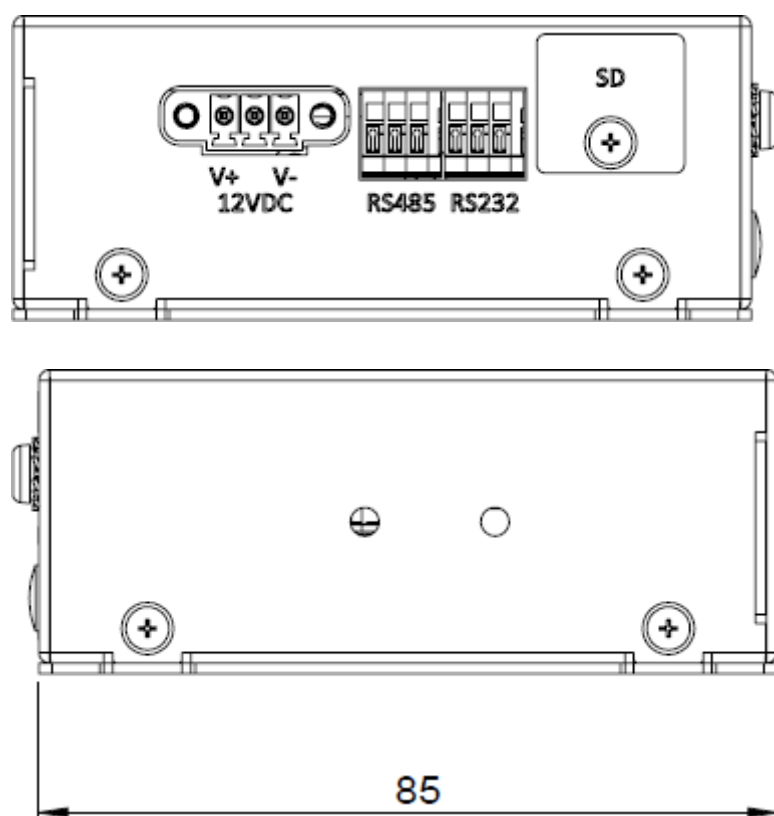


Figure 4: Side view

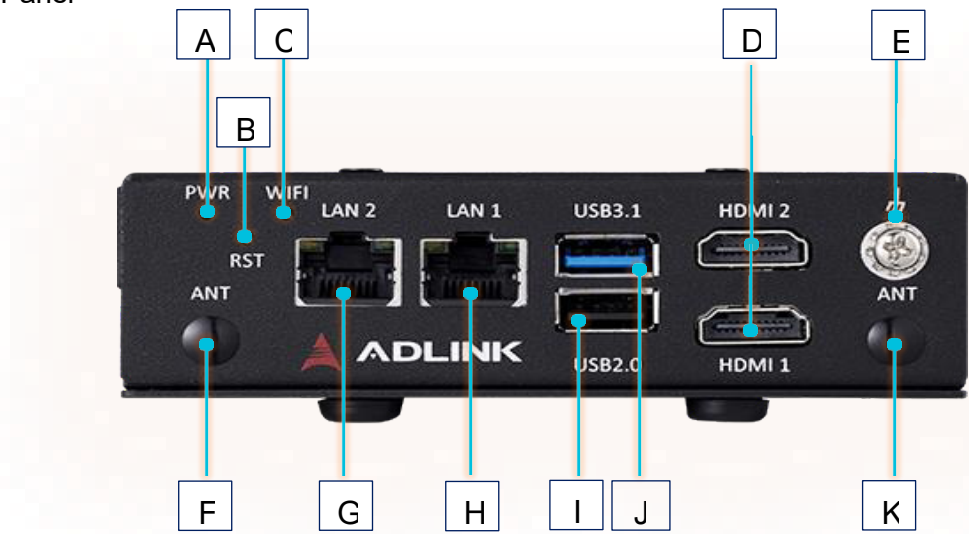


Figure 5: Front panel I/O connectors

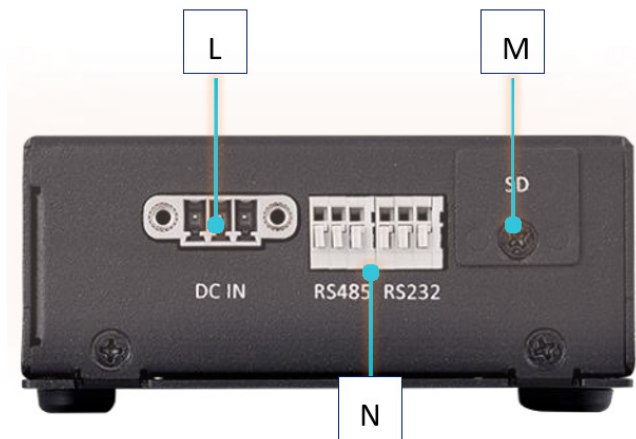


Figure 6: Rear panel I/O connectors

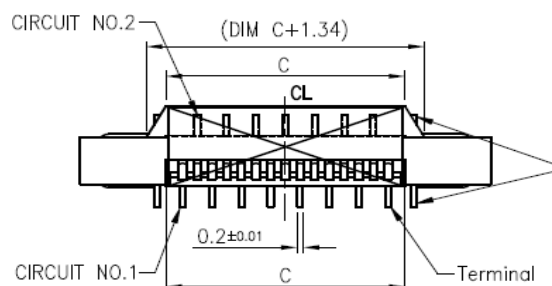
